



## Watch

'Watch' status allows you to monitor the progress of a manuscript for which you are not already a submitter, PI, or reviewing author.

Watchers can view manuscript information, and may submit a 'Claim Request' if the manuscript stalls.



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You can only submit a 'Watch Request' for a manuscript that doesn't appear in your 'My Manuscripts' list.
