When submitting a manuscript via Europe PubMed Central plus you may want to add grants from more than one author. On the grant entry page you may search for other grants from all the Funders Group members. Each grant number has a funder-specific prefix preceding the grant number, see table below. In order to search for grants in the system this prefix must be entered in the search term.
